POLICY ON PRODUCTION OF HARD COPIES OF OUR PUBLISHED ARTICLES

You will recall that since the inception of the Nigerian Journal of Physics (NJP) (ISSN Online: 3027-0936; ISSN Print: 1595 – 0611 and DOI: <u>https://doi.org/10.62292/njp</u>), the Institute have ensured regular publication of the Journal. All of these published issues were hard copies only for few copies that were uploaded by AJOL.

You will also recall that since the inception of this current Council on the 10th May 2023, the Institute have successfully commenced the online publication of our Journals to the Global audience, which are readily available at https://nip.nipngr.org/

With this online publication, we have increased the number of issues from two (2) to four (4) per year. As a result of the online publication of our Journals, the volume of hard copies being requested have drastically reduced. More so, the previous hard copies produced are still available, as members are no longer requesting for such copies.

The Council of the Nigerian Institute of Physics (NIP) have therefore revised the policy on production of hard copies of our Journals as follows:

- i. that hard copies of published Journal issues will **no longer be produced for individuals after publication**,
- ii. the Editorial Board are hereby directed to make available **cover pages** of issues published on the Journal websites for members who desires to print copies for their use, and
- iii. that however, request can be made by Institutions/Organizations for the production at the prevailing market price. Any of such request should be made specifically to:
